About the hosting organization

The hosting organization (THO) is an organisation for child and youth service. Kindervereinigung runs 13 children day-care centers, takes care of 25 daymothers, carries out school social work at 24 schools as well as school clubs at 7 schools in Leipzig and surrounding. In addition, THO has 13 open clubs for youth and projects and organizes holiday activities for children and teenagers. THO currently employs around 380 full-time staff. The work of the association is supported by about 200 volunteer workers including Bufdis (german volunteer service).

Tasks

The volunteer can be involved in different projects in the house. It is expected that he/she/they is present at the Competence Center for International Youth Work and non-formal Education for about 50 percent of the time. Depending on their skills, the focus of their work can be on public relations, organising meetings or working with young people. In addition, the volunteer can choose which other projects in the house he/she/they would like to be involved in. Volunteers can gain experience in organising international projects, in open youth work with the play mobile or in cultural youth education. We would like to determine the focus of the work together with the volunteer at the beginning of the placement year.

Conditions (short overview)

- The volunteer has a mentor, who supports with regular feedback talks at the hosting organization
- The weekly project time is 35 hours and weekends are free, as well as holidays such as Christmas, etc.
- The volunteer has two holidays per month, which can be collected to take a longer time off (Some facilities have closing times and then some vacation must be taken then.)
- There is a basic language course to support the volunteers in the beginning. The ESC is a non-formal education program and therefore no professional German course is provided, but the goal is to learn the language during the project time and outside in the free time.

Project 2

Description

In Leipzig, we have several openings for ESC volunteering in kindergarten. All kindergartens belong to the hosting organization (THO) and differ in their thematic focus and their size. Some have smaller groups and some have bigger groups.

1. THO "Bremer Str." (Aesthetic education, inclusive education and integration, religious education)
2. THO "Wilmar-Schwabe-Str." (sports, gardening, inclusive education and integration)
3. THO "Wurzner Str." (handcraft, language education, community building with intercultural district, inclusive education and integration)

Tasks

- The volunteer will work in a group with children between 3 and 7 year.
- The volunteer supports the workers in their daily routines with the kids e.g. preparation of meals, playing & watch out for the kids playing outside, accompany the children to their activities.
- The volunteer will get to know a pedagogic insight into the open work concept of the institution. This means that children have often a lot of freedom and independence in shaping their day.
- He/she/They shall actively enter aspects of his/her/their own culture into the daily life with the kids and create special projects around this.

Conditions (short overview)

- The volunteer has a mentor, who supports with regular feedback talks at the hosting organization
- The weekly project time is 35 hours and weekends are free, as well as holidays such as Christmas, etc.

Description

The host organization „eco-house of the CJD Saxony opened on September 2020. Originally it was built with local wood, straw and clay in 2008 and 2009 as a straw bale house with a green roof. It is located in the 50 hectare Agra Park, which was originally created in 1890 and is now a memorial of garden art. Some parts of the park are a landscape protection area "Leipziger Auwald" as well as protected under European Bird sanctuary.

The „eco-house combines youth work with gardening and nature. But we also want too develop the house as open meeting places for naturalists, nature adventure garden, with special school holiday and youth programs and project days to heighten an awareness for natural habitat. Children and young people strengthen their social skills and responsible behavior and develop their skills in natural science, art and the environment.

A second working place is a youth center/open point for children and youth not far from the eco-house. It is a place where young people design there leisure time supported by the staff. Apart from games, sports and music job orientation and learning to lead a self-sustained life are important topics of the work with the youths.

Tasks

In the eco-house the volunteer works with young people, in the garden area and on the different projects. Beside daily gardening there are special nature youth activities that can be supported or created by the volunteer. The volunteers helps within nature education projects and it is foreseen that the volunteer develops and realize with the support of the staff own nature education offers. The eco-house is still in the initial phase so ideas and own projects of the volunteer are welcome. In the youth club the volunteer support the youths and the staff designing and carrying through leisure activities on a daily base as well as special projects which have a longer duration. The volunteer shall bring aspects of his or her own country into the work, e.g. music, games, sports, language, cooking or handicraft.

About the hosting organization

The host organization Leipzig is an international production centre for contemporary figure and object theatre. In our programming we put an emphasis on the international ensemble connected with our theatre, the support of upcoming artists in the field of figure theatre and related genres and the desire to be open to artistic experimentation. In addition to the associated ensembles who work here regularly, Wilde & Vogel and Lehmann and Wenzel, host organization maintains a permanent working relationship with many artists and is closely linked to the national and international theatre scene.

Host organization historically protected art nouveau building has held theatre performances since 2003, as well as ball nights, modern dance performances, concerts, exhibition and more. The focus of our program lies on object theatre and puppetry. We take part in (co)producing and supporting new productions as well as showing international performances.

The building is owned by the host organization founded in 2005. The association is also responsible for carefully rehabilitating and preserving this historic landmark. In 2012 the (culture) bar froelich & herrlich opened on the ground floor. The bar is open on Fridays as well as during the events at host organization. An active team of volunteers supports the staff in running the theatre and the bar.

Team

The host organization team consists of four permanent part-time employees and another six people who are involved as freelancers and as artists*. They form the board of the artistic management. Together we take care of the artistic program, the historic house and the structural, administrative operation.

We work in a quite familiar way, with the claim to act as low in hierarchy and as non-discriminatory as possible.

Tasks and opportunities

The range of tasks that arises in our theatre is wide. Due to the very small structure, we are flexible to respond to the talents and interests of our team members.

Your tasks will include the evening services at the house (on average, this is 1-2 per week and includes performance support and bar service). Further tasks which are handles by everyone in the team are taking care of the guest ensembles and the daily tasks at the house (from cleaning the toilets to heating the ovens to cleaning the guest apartment)

Tasks in which you could gain experience and contribute are e.g.

- event organization
- Press and public relations
- Management of a cultural enterprise
- Technical realization of the guest performances
- Support of the volunteers

Depending on your interests, it is possible to bring in your own ideas in these areas and implement them (e.g. your own social media channel, a series of events in the bar, etc.).

Since we are NOT a theatre group, we cannot offer the possibility to be on stage or to be part of a production.

About the hosting organization

The institution is a kindergarden host organization, founded in 1969, since 1993 as independent non-profit institution with a capacity of 109 children (90 kindergarden places including 4 integration places and 19 nursery places). The children are looked after by 18 pedagogues. The institution focusses on several points that are implemented: The main focus is a bilingual profile (German-French) - realized so far in 3 groups: 2 kindergarden groups since 2004, a crèche group since 2017 with the aim to provide children with early, at least bilingual everyday integrated care, support and education to facilitate, promote and develop an open intercultural exchange for children over one-year-old; Development/consolidation/training of the social-communicative and intercultural competencies of children, professionals and parents; Incorporation of French culture in the annual cycle through appropriate offers and networking within the city.

Our other main focuses are: - Integration: 4 children with special living conditions are supported and accompanied by appropriately trained staff in 2 groups. - In one group, the musical abilities and skills of the children are additionally promoted by a music education specialist.

There are cooperation/memberships to 2 elementary schools (of which one offers the continuation of the bilingual profile in primary education), the French institute, another German-French kindergarden, the association and the city library

Tasks

The volunteer supports the workers in their daily routines with the kids and shall set up own small or bigger projects in the kindergarden. He/She will get to know a pedagogic insight into the work of a bilingual kindergarden. The volunteer will work in a group with children between 2 and 7 years. He/She will get to know and co-arrange the work with the parents; participate in important processes like preparing elder kids for school, attend projects that are carried through in the second language French. He/she shall actively enter aspects of his/her own culture into the daily life with the kids and create special projects around this. He/she shall carry through an own project, for example in the fields of theatre, music or dance.

- The volunteer has a mentor, who supports with regular feedback talks at the hosting organization
- The weekly project time is 35 hours and weekends are free, as well as holidays such as Christmas, etc.

Description

The host organization Leipzig was founded in 1990 and accommodates about 350 students. The host organization leads students from grade 1 to grade 13. The ESC will be in the e day nursery, which is associated with the school. The host organization pedagogy pursues a holistic approach within children's mental and intellectual education. The curriculum is structured by the pupils' stages of development and aims at supporting and developing intellectual, mental and physical skills appropriate for the respective age. The day nursery offers a mentoring program in the afternoon for grades 1-4 (6 – 10 years). The staff of the Free host organization school consists of around 50 members. Two members are directly involved in the project. Moreover, there are between 50 and 100 adult voluntary helpers working at the school.

Tasks

The volunteer will mainly be active in the day nursery (grades 1-4 / 6-10 years) to support the staff during the lunch times and the afternoon activities (games, special projects). According to the interests of the volunteer, he/she may also carry through special creative projects with the kids (singing, dancing...). The volunteer shall present aspects of his or her own country, e.g. music, language, games, handicraft or cooking. The volunteer's own ideas can be realized in every-day work during the afternoons as well as in various projects, parties etc. The volunteer also has the chance to develop an own project during the year. The opportunities for children and teenagers to acquire intercultural competence are scarce in the East of Germany. Thus, the Waldorf nursery sees a volunteer as a huge enrichment! Being a self-administrative community with the support of 240 families, we are open to any kind of integration for the volunteer. The volunteer can take part in a language course.

- The weekly project time is 35 hours and weekends are free, as well as holidays such as Christmas, etc.
