## About the hosting organization

We are an association of parents of people with intellectual functional diversity, declared of Public Utility by the Ministry of the Interior, which was created more than 50 years ago in the region of La Safor. It is directed by a Board of Directors in parents' assembly and we work so that people with functional diversity and their families have a dignified life and can enjoy a project for the future.

We have 2 main residences, one in Potries and another in Gandia. There are 115 people working in our centers. In the residence of Gandia there are a total of 20 users while 44 users are in Potries.

Rehabilitation activities are carried out (physiotherapy room, rehabilitation pool, stimulation room and personal autonomy), with appropriate staff, physiotherapists, educators and psychologists.

In the occupational center, therapies are carried out with subcontracted jobs handmade wool carpets, pottery workshop, hand-painted fans, bead workshop (such as bracelets, pendants, etc.) and details for gifts and printing (such as mugs, T-shirts, Christmas baskets). We also have theatre workshops and a theatre show that our users create during the year.

We also have programs for initial professional qualification, gardening, cleaning, cooking. Training and job placement workshops and comprehensive employment plans, as well as a special employment center., where 70% of the employees are people with intellectual functional diversity.

Group activities are carried out on Friday and Saturday afternoons to give walks and snacks to our users of the center or even to people who do not belong to it but are associated to the entity to be able to have this service.

Short-term activities out of the center are carried out, in which a group of users with monitors go to a hostel from Friday to Sunday with activities both within the facilities of the hostel and outside it, visiting tourist areas of the town.

At Project center we work so that the intellectually disabled and their families have a dignified life and can enjoy a project for the future. We offer:

- > RESIDENCE AND DAY CENTRE
- > Rehabilitation activities (physiotherapy room, rehabilitation pool, sensory stimulation room) and personal autonomy, with appropriate staff, physiotherapists, educators, psychologists...
- > OCCUPATIONAL CENTRE with initial professional qualification programs.
- > LEISURE with summer camps, weekend outings, family breaks, trips.
- > THERAPEUTIC GROUPS for parents
- > Self-advocacy groups

**PLEASE READ VERY CAREFULLY:**

**This is a challenging project with people with intellectual functional diversity. Background of these people might be delicate with difficult life situations that provokes that their behavior might tends to be verbally aggressive/complicated. It's very demanding but also extremely enriching and satisfying for volunteers. Please take this into consideration before applying for this project.**

## Activities

There will be a very wide range of possible activities available for the volunteers, with a maximum of 35 hours per week and being able to help and give support in tasks such as:

Excursions to the different porrats of the villages of the Safor: They are usually at weekends, when they do not have a day centre or activity centre. We go to the Porrat where we visit the craft market, go on the fairground rides and have a snack or refreshment.

Cinema visits: we arrange a visit to the cinema to confirm and reserve the seats we need, we buy popcorn and soft drinks and we enjoy the film we have chosen together. When the film is over, we take a walk around the shopping centre.

Trips for walks and snacks: We usually have many activities out of this type as we all like to get out of the house and socialise with the rest of society either walking or just sitting on a terrace having a drink and watching other people go by. We usually choose a different town and sometimes there are towns where they used to live with their relatives and where there are still people they know and can see when they pass by.

Cooking/handicraft workshops: a group of residents, together with an assistant, go shopping for what is needed to carry out the programmed activity, cooking or any other type of handicraft.

Relaxing baths with salts, essences and massages: at appropriate times and for those users who like and enjoy this activity, relaxing baths with essences and special soaps for residents in which they can relax and enjoy at a prudent time of disconnection and the pleasant scent of the essences.

Weekend walks on the beach: At weekends and when the weather is good (especially in winter) we go for walks on the beach in groups. Sometimes along the promenade or along the shore, depending on the season.

Organising Christmas, Easter, Valentine's Day, Fallas, Carnival, Peace Day: We love to celebrate all the holidays with our friends and monitors, like putting up the Christmas decorations, Valentine's Day, choosing our costume and dressing up.

Decorating the organisation's premises in Potries: To be able to organise a good party or celebration, it is necessary to have a good decoration and we are very good at decorating with things bought and made handicrafts by reusing materials.

Water activities (in summer): As we have a swimming pool in the center, we like to go swimming in the summer and organise activities of free choice and rhythm as aqua-gym.

Watching films with popcorn and/or snacks: We have multipurpose rooms where we have a projector where we can show films or do karaoke and others dance or vice versa.

Sensory and musical stimulation sessions: Different materials are used to carry out stimulation sessions so that our users who are unable to do other types of activities can do and discover through touch or sound a variety of manipulative or auditory objects.

Assemblies: our users give their opinion on what activities they want to do, where they want to go for a drink, a walk or other activities of their choice.

The accommodation will be in private rooms in a shared apartment situated in Gandia (together with other ESC volunteers from other project) and all the expenses in the house will be paid by the organisation (electricity, internet, water, gas). Each volunteer will receive a SIM card for their telephone and a bicycle to move around locally.

In addition, they will have the option of getting a fertile small holding for themselves to grow their own vegetables, fruits and herbs. We will give them all the support needed to start, but they will have to compromise to take care of it.

Once a month (starting by arrival date) each volunteer will receive their pocket money and food money for a total of 330€ (6€/day as pocket money and 5€/day for food).

### About the hosting organization

The hosting organization is a non-profit organisation with extensive experience in the field of social action. It provides its services in the province of Valencia within the Valencian Community. Among its founding objectives are the promotion of the solidarity of the community and the help to the integral development of all the people who are in a situation of vulnerability. To this end, the organisation tries to combine peace, truth and justice in its actions, encouraging responsibility and hard work.

The mission of hosting organization, as a community action, is to promote the integral development of people and villages, working with people who are homeless or at high risk of social exclusion.

The entity's project is fully in line with the European Union, which considers social inclusion as a key priority for the member countries by establishing a process to ensure that people at risk of poverty and social exclusion are given greater opportunities and resources to participate fully in economic, social, cultural life and labour market, to enjoy a worthy standard of living and well-being, as well as to ensuring access to fundamental rights for vulnerable groups and individuals.

The organisation is committed to providing an effective response to those who are homeless or at high risk of social exclusion and to achieve the objectives that the European Union has identified as priorities.

The objectives of hosting organization are:

- > To encourage, guide, promote and coordinate, in the field of action and social promotion for the integral promotion of people, especially the most vulnerable.
- > To be a meeting and collaboration place to jointly promote initiatives of the Parish Caritas of the city of Gandia within the scope of the corresponding Agreement signed between them.
- > Integral human development of the most vulnerable and the promotion of an inclusive society.
- > Denouncing the causes of poverty and exclusion and promoting social values.
- > Integral ecology as a new paradigm of justice, social intervention and care.

## Summary of the project

During the last years, the demand for the services offered by hosting organization as grown exponentially as a result of the permanent crisis in which we are living. Every time there are more and more people in a situation or at risk of social exclusion, living on the streets or in substandard housing. As a result, all the areas and projects of our organisation are at full capacity.

Therefore the organisation is developing and increasing the quantity and quality of the services we offer to people in all areas, which makes our organisation and the projects we run an essential resource for responding to the increasingly evident need of the people we serve.

We expect volunteers to support our organisation with all the services we offer, both as basic needs and specific activities regarding attention to families and migrants, social services, literacy and digital training, vocational workshops, activities to promote equity, school support for children with disabilities, socio-occupational integration projects, sports, etc.

## Activities

There will be a very wide range of possible activities available for the volunteers with a maximum of 35 hours per week. Please take into consideration that all volunteers will have to volunteer some weekends (having other week days free). Some of the tasks are:

- > Reception, attention and information about our work and possible help, with subsequent referral to the appropriate resource.
- > Comprehensive and specific attention to cases referred by social agencies.
- > Specialised attention (inclusive employment, migration, communication, etc.).
- > Specific activities (workshops/training courses, school reinforcement for minors, adult literacy, awareness, cultural and leisure activities, sports, etc.).
- > Attention to basic needs: accommodation, food, clothing, personal hygiene and assistance.
- > Comprehensive care, personalised according to the characteristics of each resident.
- > Management and monitoring of the person's health. From 2020, the centre has a nursing service responsible for managing and monitoring the medical processes of each resident.
- > Support and assistance with the necessary administrative and documentary formalities.
- > Cognitive, psychological, empowerment and self-esteem workshops, or any other area suggested by the residents.
- > Weekly participative meetings to discuss problems arising from daily life in the centre.
- > Workshops on the preparation of healthy menus.
- > Vocational workshops (handicrafts, organic farming, gardening, raising farm animals, etc.).

In addition, the Day Centre "Casa - Hogar María Teresa Marques" offers meals, showers, laundry, hairdressing, laundry, left-luggage office, socio-educational accompaniment, psychological care and a service of weather emergencies, distribution of healthy snacks, dining room, library. As well as activities and workshops: Spanish language, relaxation, social skills, art, sports, equality and motivation for change, cinema and participants' assembly.

The shelters offer a comprehensive support service, which includes specific services for families/guests according to their needs and the objectives agreed in each personalized intervention process. In this way, by monitoring the intervention plans drawn up we can offer:

- > Meeting basic needs (food, hygiene, health, education, etc.).
- > Emotional support.
- > Personal accompaniment (for all kinds of paperwork and formalities).
- > Acquisition and reinforcement of basic social work, personal resource management, health.
- > Promotional and recreational activities to promote social integration.

### Hosting/coordinating organization

Hosting organization is a non-profit youth cultural association created in Gandia (Valencia, Spain) in 2014 by an enthusiastic group of people who decided to leave their regular jobs and try to enjoy their day by day while doing something enriching and meaningful for their local communities. It's an active member of the Council of Youth of Gandia and our objectives are:

- To encourage and facilitate the international mobility of youth a
- and youth workers (especially for groups with fewer opportunities).
  - To expand social cooperation projects and volunteering (local and international).
  - To empower youth in order for them to have their own critical thinking and analysis, an active citizenship and participatory democracy.
  - To enhance values of tolerance, human dignity, interculturality, solidarity and cooperation, social justice and integration.
  - To promote healthy lifestyles and the protection of the environment through a sustainable development.

### Training during the activity

Far from improving, the environmental situation nowadays is becoming worse day by day reaching a point of "no return" that would be terrible for our Nature and Planet.

We believe that our best way to try changing this is taking action and raising awareness amongst the population, especially youth who will suffer the most the consequences of our current actions.

That is the reason why this project focuses on action-awareness and environmental activism, and aims to show that the garbage we produce in our daily life can not only be reduced, but can also be reused, thus generating new economy and possible business especially for people with fewer opportunities and /or social problems. We also want to empower youth developing their ideas and transforming them into real projects.

Therefore with this project we will be combining:

- Environmental issues (MAIN PROJECT):
  - Precious Plastic machines which transform plastic waste into new and valuable objects.
- Awareness campaigns and workshops
  - Workshops for children with less opportunities and youth from the region.
  - Awareness campaigns started by volunteers about any topic that they might consider relevant in the region.
  - Erasmus+ and other European programs campaigns, info sessions and workshops.
- Non-formal management
  - Starting and managing a non-profit organisation.
  - Writing and delivering projects based on non-formal education.

## Objectives

1. To empower youth of the region (especially with fewer opportunities) by giving them the necessary skills and knowledge to create and manage a non-profit association, including writing and coordinating projects;
2. To boost the entrepreneurial spirit of volunteers and local youth (especially with fewer opportunities) by providing them with the tools, knowledge and skills necessary to develop their own ideas and projects;
3. To encourage and facilitate national and international mobility of youth (through exchanges, courses, volunteering ...) including European youth cooperation and European programs;
4. To raise awareness among the youth of the region about environmental conservation, active citizenship, social inclusion, healthy habits, converting them into multiplier agents of change;
5. To promote values of tolerance, inclusion, interculturality, solidarity and sustainability among the volunteers and the youth of the region;
6. To support the most disadvantaged sectors of the local community (social and educational centres) through workshops, events and activities;

## Activities

There will be a very wide range of possible activities available for the volunteers. However, each volunteer will have to choose and be responsible for one of the 3 main topics: Environmental issues (precious plastic), Workshops for unprivileged children and awareness campaigns for youth, or Non-formal projects management. They will all collaborate in the different projects, but the responsible person will be in charge of organising the work, promote it and do weekly follow up of the results/outcomes.

These are some necessary tasks but flexibility will be always present in the schedule.

Some of the projects where volunteers will get involved in host are:

### 1) ENVIRONMENTAL ISSUES (MAIN PROJECT):

· PRECIOUS PLASTIC: it's an environmental Global project aiming to make people more aware of the amount of plastic waste generated nowadays, and to show how can be shredded and transformed into new useful/common objects.

Back in 2017 we started building the machines in Gandia (capital city of the region "La Safor") and we called it "Plàstic Preciós La Safor" (in Valencian language). It took us some time but finally we managed to finish the 4 machines in April 2019 and they are perfectly working:

- > Shredder: to shred plastic waste into plastic flakes, we have now 2 of them.
- > Extrusion: to create new plastic wire and other objects. We also have 2 of them.
- > Slow moulding and injection: to produce any plastic product from a mould. We got 2 injection machines and one moulding.

Now we also have a press sheet to create plastic sheets up to 2 cm and a CNC machine to create any shape we want from those plastic sheets.

We are doing workshops and exhibitions for schools and other educational centers, music and environmental festivals, private companies, events...and whoever is interested in the project.

Of course we are also creating plastic products.

Volunteers could help in any of that. And there is still a lot of work to do and we need some support from very motivated people! Some of the tasks that volunteers will be doing are:

- Sorting and shredding plastic waste by colour and type.
- Supporting us coming to workshops in schools and other events.
- Designing promotional materials, posters, roll-up and others.
- Creating audio-visual materials (photo, video, timelapses...). We would love to have different types of videos and material in order to promote what we do.
- Improving our website and being our Community Manager (instagram, facebook, youtube...).
- Producing new plastic objects with the machines.
- Designing new products and moulds.
- Finding ways of funding for this project and others related.
- Finding new local and international partners for collaborations and local volunteers to collaborate.
- Researching companies around the region who might be interested in collaborations, giving us their plastic waste or any other type of alliance.
- Any other task relevant for the project that volunteers decide to implement.
- Writing, managing and/or facilitating Erasmus+ projects such as Youth Exchanges related to environmental topics.
- Creating new campaigns and projects related to environmental issues.

## 2) AWARENESS CAMPAIGNS & WORKSHOPS:

1. Workshops for unprivileged children (from Roma communities and migrants, mainly from Morocco) in collaboration with the social center

2. Awareness campaigns for youth: creating and developing activities, campaigns and events for promoting sustainability, responsible consumption, healthy life style, interculturality, tolerance, participatory democracy, social justice, cooperation and solidarity, human dignity, or any other topic that the group of volunteers consider important.

## 3) NON-FORMAL MANAGMENT:

- acquiring the knowledge to be able to start and manage a non-profit organisation;
- creating a new website and keeping it updated, as well as our social networks;
- helping with the design of logos and promotional materials for the association;
- helping to write, organise and facilitate Erasmus+ activities (especially youth exchanges);
- Promotion of Erasmus+ and other European programs to encourage youth participation.

## Practical details (participants, food, accommodation...)

The accommodation will be in private rooms in a shared apartment situated in Gandia and all the expenses in the house will be paid by the organisation (electricity, internet, water, gas). Each volunteer will receive a SIM card for their telephone and a bicycle to move around locally.

In addition, as Valencian Community is a highly fertile and agriculturally active region from Spain, they will have the option of getting a fertile small holding for.

Once a month (starting by arrival date) each volunteer will receive their pocket money and food money for a total of 330€ (180€ as pocket money and 150€ for food). Volunteers will buy their own food.

## Participants profile

We are looking for highly motivated volunteers coming from any of the programme countries (for 1st project) or partner countries (for 2nd project) listed here with a very positive attitude and initiative, adaptable to change, with problem-solving capacity and able to work both independently and as a team member.

The ideal candidates should have experience, studies or a major interest in:

- Transformation of waste with precious plastic (and some Upcycling optional);
- Digital fabrication and product/graphic design [able to work with software or/and hardware (CNC, 3D printers, CAD, 3DMax...)];
- Environmental campaigns, cleaning events, sustainability or self-sufficiency issues;
- Audio-visuals, digital content, web creation, CM, online marketing...;
- Writing/delivering/managing non-formal education and volunteering projects (Erasmus+ (especially KA2), Creative Europe, ESC, Young Entrepreneurs...);

Based on previous experiences at least a basic level of Spanish language (at least B1) is required for this project.
