This is who we are!

The Diversity, joy of life, participation, and support are our focus: the host organization – Supporting Together offers a wide range of social services for children, adolescents, and adults with disabilities. We accompany around 3000 people – from kindergarten through school up to work or care. The focus is always on how we can support and encourage people to shape their lives as independently as possible.

The host organization is an abbreviation for "Gemeinnützige Gesellschaft für Paritätische Sozialarbeit mbH Wilhelmshaven" (Non-Profit Association for Parity Social Work Wilhelmshaven). The host organization was founded in 1968 and today employs around 1300 staff members at 60 locations within the city of Wilhelmshaven and the surrounding districts. We offer many opportunities and exciting jobs for young people who wish to work in youth welfare, integration assistance, elderly care, or in one of our six workshops for people with disabilities.

For children and adolescents, the host organization offers care, support, and help from the first year of life until adulthood (and beyond). From kindergarten and schools to an Autism Therapy Center and outpatient assistance, our employees support families in every situation. Children and adolescents with developmental delays or disabilities and their families receive special support when facing difficulties.

Furthermore, the host organization offers assistance in everyday life and with housing. There are day centres for people with psychological illnesses and older people. There are residential homes, outpatient living arrangements, support in one's own home, and an outpatient nursing service.

At the host organization, great importance is placed on an open, constructive working atmosphere. You are expressly welcome to bring your own ideas and projects to the workplace – we look forward to getting to know you and your culture!

About the activity

The host organization is an educational institution for children with disabilities. Students complete their 12-year compulsory schooling in small groups, which allows for individual fostering of personal strengths and competencies, as well as a practice-oriented school education. In the final grades, the adolescents are prepared for professional life and independent living and housing. The staff focuses on strengths rather than weaknesses to achieve individual goals.

You will accompany the skilled workers in organizing lessons or with individual support measures. You will help the students with dressing, eating, and support them in acquiring competencies. Your tasks include preparing the group room and preparing meals. You will be involved in the organization of projects and participate in excursions and class trips.

About the activity

The host organization provides accommodation for adults with physical and intellectual impairments. Professionals support the residents with care, daily routines, leisure activities, administrative tasks, and doctor appointments. During the day, residents work in our workshops. For retired residents, there is the option to attend a day care centre. The service is offered seven days a week, mainly in the afternoons and evenings, as well as on weekends.

Your tasks include supporting the professionals in daily activities and individual tasks. You motivate participation in offers, excursions, and events. Care tasks are usually only minimally supportive. Household duties include preparing the common group room, assisting with tidiness in the rooms, and preparing meals. You can contribute to projects like seasonal festivals and are welcome to implement your own ideas.

The guiding principle of the host organization is to give every person with psychological impairments the time to stabilize and develop a perspective for their future path. The employees always offer an open ear, advise, support, and promote the motivation to become active, but also respect the boundaries of each individual within the group. Your place of deployment is the stationary supported living arrangement—the clients are intensively accompanied in their daily lives. These groups consist of three to four flatmates who live in single rooms and share an apartment. You support the professionals in organizing the daily routine or individual tasks and encourage the residents to acquire or maintain skills. You motivate participation in activities, therapeutic offers, and events. You are also involved in projects such as seasonal festivals and participate in excursions.

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Furthermore, the host organization offers assistance with daily living and housing. There are day centres for people with psychological illnesses and for older people. We offer residential homes, outpatient housing forms, support in one's own home, and an outpatient nursing service.

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About the activity

In the Residential Home, 22 people—some of whom require a high level of support—live together. The residents usually attend the host organization’s workshop in Wilhelmshaven during the day. In the middle of the property, there is a garden house called “Sonnenseite” (Sunny Side), which serves as a meeting place for retired individuals.

Your tasks include accompaniment, care, and household duties. You assist the professional team in organizing the daily routine and individual support measures, and you support the residents in acquiring new skills and maintaining their existing abilities. You motivate them to participate in meaningful activities, therapeutic offers, and events in the residential home and/or in the day care located in the garden house. You accompany residents when shopping, eating out, or taking part in other activities.

Care tasks include personal hygiene and assistance with dressing and undressing. Household tasks involve laundry care, helping keep individual rooms tidy, and preparing meals.

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About the activity

The host organization's Wilhelmshaven Workshop offers diverse work and employment opportunities for people with various disabilities: metal and wood processing, assembly work, garden maintenance, a Day Support Centre (Tagesförderstätte), and leisure activities. The goal is to enable people to participate in working life.

Your tasks include accompaniment, care, and housekeeping in the Day Support Centre. This facility cares for, supports, and promotes people with a high need for assistance. They experience a varied daily structure, attention, community, and relaxation. Accompaniment means participating in shaping daily routines and supporting people in acquiring competencies and carrying out work assignments. Care tasks include personal hygiene and assistance with meals. Housekeeping tasks involve preparing meals and supporting the maintenance of tidiness in the group room.

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About the activity

The host organization Wilhelmshaven has 4 residential groups, each offering space for 10 to 12 children and youth with disabilities. The goal of the work is to enable them to lead a life that is as independent as possible. Professionals provide support with care, the organization of daily and leisure activities, and therapeutic appointments. Furthermore, they promote personality development and social competencies.

Your tasks include accompaniment, care, and housekeeping. You assist the professionals with the daily routine, with support measures, and support the young people in acquiring competencies. You motivate participation in activities and events. You provide accompaniment for shopping, eating out, or other activities. Care includes personal hygiene and assistance with dressing and undressing. Household tasks concern laundry care, assistance with keeping the rooms tidy, and the preparation of meals.

Doğru formatı kullanın

Projeye seçilmek, sadece başvurmakla değil, aynı zamanda dikkatle hazırlanmış bir başvuruyla mümkündür.

- Mektubunuzu İngilizce veya projenin dilinde yazmayı tercih edin.
- Mektubunuzun uzunluğuna dikkat edin. 1 sayfayı geçmemesi önemlidir.

Motivasyon Mektubu ve/ya Başvuru Formu vb.) hazırlayınız. Belgelerinizi hazırladıktan sonra aşağıdaki adımları izleyerek başvurunuzu tamamlayabilirsiniz;

- Başvuru için ilk olarak <https://genclikcalismalari.org/> web sitesinde üye girişi yapınız. Eğer üyelik hesabınız yoksa bir hesap oluşturmanız gerekmektedir.
- Daha sonra ilanın yayınlandığı sayfada yer alan "**Başvur**" butonuna tıklayınız ve açılan pencerede sizden talep edilen belgeleri ayrı ayrı ilgili alanlara yükleyiniz. Hangi belgelerin talep edildiği bilgi paketinde belirtilmiştir.
- Belgeleri yükledikten sonra pencerenin alt kısmına yer alan "**Sonraki**" butonuna basınız. Yeni pencerede karşınıza "**Başvur**" butonu çıkacaktır.
