This is who we are!

The host organization is Northern Europe's oldest organic farming school. Approximately 100 students and future farmers are educated in areas such as animal husbandry, crop cultivation, technical skills, social studies, economics, production, and management.

The host organization is located in the beautiful Danish countryside, close to water, forests, and cultivated fields. Both individually and collectively, strong emphasis is placed on ecology, community, development, credibility, and quality in all activities.

Students have the option to live at the host organization, which helps foster close relationships among students and staff. The atmosphere is informal, making it an ideal placement for volunteers who are not afraid of hands-on work, such as digging vegetables or helping care for animals in the stables.

The host organization offers an international program called "Global Organic Farmer," in which approximately 70% of the students are Danish and 30% are international students from EU countries. International and Danish students live together at the school, creating a truly international environment. The staff includes agronomists, agricultural technologists, kitchen staff, farmers, IT specialists, management, consultants, and craftsmen. In total, around 25 people work at the host organization, all of whom are experienced in handling intercultural and interlinguistic differences among young people.

The host organization is located about a 15-minute walk from the town of Rønde (approximately 3,000 inhabitants, with various shops) and next to Mols Bjerge National Park. Aarhus, Denmark's second-largest city, can be reached in around 30 minutes by bus, with several bus lines providing regular connections.







About the activity

At the host organization, volunteers in the kitchen will engage in a dynamic program centered around sustainable food systems. The kitchen prepares daily meals for 80–125 people, using organic produce from the school's farm. Volunteers will assist in meal preparation, food preservation (such as pickling, freezing, and drying surplus produce), menu planning, and maintaining a clean and organized kitchen environment. This role emphasizes sustainability, minimizing food waste, and promoting farm-to-table practices.

In general, the volunteer will gain hands-on experience in sustainable kitchen operations, learn about organic food production, and explore how local and seasonal ingredients are integrated into nutritious meals. Volunteers will also have the opportunity to share their own cultural food traditions and recipes, enriching the school's culinary offerings. While kitchen activities follow a structured schedule, volunteers may occasionally participate in events or activities outside normal working hours, with compensatory time off provided.

The volunteer will live at the host organization alongside the students and will be encouraged to integrate into the vibrant community life. The school offers a wide range of student-driven social activities and facilities, including choir, a fitness room, table tennis, pool, and football. The beautiful surroundings invite volunteers to explore the nearby forest, bike or walk in nature, and even swim in the ocean. Aarhus, Denmark's second-largest city, is also easily accessible and offers a wide range of cultural and leisure opportunities.

Volunteer Profile

The volunteer must be between 18 and 30 years old. The recruitment process is open to all, but it is preferred that the volunteer has a keen interest in learning about sustainable food systems, organic cooking, and reducing food waste. We will highly value a volunteer who enjoys working in a kitchen environment and is enthusiastic about preparing meals, preserving produce, and contributing to the farm-to-table cycle. A willingness to collaborate, try new things, and bring their own cultural food traditions to the table will be greatly appreciated.

NB. This activity may ultimately be a mixed farming & kitchen position. Thus, applicants must be ready for that. This will be clearly communicated in good time.







Seminars

As a volunteer within the ESC programme, 2 seminars are offered by the Denmark National Agency, in which the volunteer will meet other volunteers involved in other organizations activities and from all over Denmark.

Travel

Travel costs of the volunteer from to Denmark and back will be reimbursed to a maximum in accordance with the European Commission distance calculator and European Solidarity Corps Program Guide.

Accommodation, food and transport arrangements

Accommodation will be provided by the host organization.

Pocket money

The hosting organization will give the monthly allowance to the volunteer.

Food and Transport

The hosting organization will give the monthly allowance to the volunteer.

Visa and resident permit

For non-EU volunteers who might need a visa and stay permit, there is a budget to cover all the administrative costs. The volunteer has to keep all the invoices and proof of the expenses to be reimbursed in Denmark.

Language course

The volunteer will have access to the Online Linguistic Support offered by the EU Academy of ESC programme, that will help him/her in learning the Danish language.

Insurance

Health insurance will be provided by the ESC program.
