This is who we are!

Inclusion Services deal with reception and support for migrant people, social housing and interventions for the most vulnerable subjects, guided by respect for people's rights and dignity. They are organized in three main services: reception facilities, social housing and a community center. All the services foreseen linguistic and cultural mediations. An Italian language school is active across all services.

Reception centers for asylum seekers and refugees are organized into three main operational projects: CAS, SAI, and Humanitarian Corridors. They provide reception services and facilities for single men, women, and families, in cooperation with local authorities. Social operators support migrants throughout their integration process, including assistance with documentation, orientation to the labor market and local services, and housing searches. They also promote academic inclusion for both children and adults. Operators help beneficiaries address personal, health, and psychological needs and guide them toward autonomy in accessing local services.

Social Housing is a service that assists people experiencing housing difficulties. Diaconia Valdese offers apartments for diverse groups of people, providing support in job reintegration, housing searches, orientation, access to local services, socialization activities, and legal assistance. Accommodation is provided to adults facing economic hardship, migrants excluded from institutional protection systems, single women, mother/child families, and students in financial difficulty.

Volunteers have the opportunity to live and train in a community and multicultural environment, facing challenges that encourage reflection and active participation. The volunteer experience includes supporting the work of the reception structure and engaging in activities designed to foster personal growth on emotional, professional, and relational levels.

Community Center Milano is part of a national network of ten community centers active in different Italian cities. The help desk provides orientation for Italian language courses and professional training, assistance with drafting CVs and job search guidance, administrative and legal advice, housing searches and applications for public housing, as well as support for all social secretariat procedures. Additionally, Centro Milano Donna 7 is a specific center and safe space exclusively for women, offering all help desk services along with recreational activities.

About the activity

The volunteers will have the opportunity to live and train in a context of community and multicultural life, crossed by challenges that lead to questioning and participation actively. The service will be characterized by activities in order to support the work of the reception structure and by activities of reflection and reworking of the personal path at an emotional, professional and relational level.

Volunteers at Social Housing and Reception centres will support the staff with the daily planning, homework support for children, Job seeking and orientation to local services. Volunteers will participate in extra-curricular initiatives involving University corridor students, with the possibility of socializing and starting cultural exchanges with young people from all over the world.

Volunteers will participate to the organization and implementation of the leisure activities across all the services, such as the visit to the municipal museum, registration to the public library, the organization of the activity for the religious festivity (dinner for Christmas, or Eid al Fitr, cooking lab for the Orthodox Easter), the training of the football team or the other sportive events; they will take part to the workshop proposed to the beneficiaries.

Volunteers will help also the accounting with the administrative reporting procedures.

Volunteers will be actively involved in the weekly planning of the tasks, and according to their own personal interest and skills she/he/they will have the opportunities to propose their own activities act as main characters in the creation of a constructive and inclusive intercultural dialogue, developed on several levels and with different means of communication.

Seminars

As a volunteer within the ESC programme, 2 seminars are offered by the Italy National Agency, in which the volunteer will meet other volunteers involved in other organizations activities and from all over Italy.

Travel

Travel costs of the volunteer from to Italy and back will be reimbursed to a maximum in accordance with the European Commission distance calculator and European Solidarity Corps Program Guide.

Accommodation, food and transport arrangements

Accommodation will be provided by the host organization.

Pocket money

The hosting organization will give the monthly allowance to the volunteer.

The hosting organization will give the monthly allowance to the volunteer.

Visa and resident permit

For non-EU volunteers who might need a visa and stay permit, there is a budget to cover all the administrative costs.

The volunteer has to keep all the invoices and proof of the expenses to be reimbursed in Italy.

Language course

The volunteer will have access to the Online Linguistic Support offered by the EU Academy of ESC programme, that will help him/her in learning the Italian language.

Insurance

Health insurance will be provided by the ESC program.
