Atelier Lávka is part of Legato – center of leisure time in Kohoutovice district in Brno which exists since 1999. Both Lávka and Legato are part of Luzanky center. Lávka offers different types of leisure-time activities: programs for schools, clubs, competitions, summer camps for children and other events for public.

About the activity

Atelier Lávka focuses on film, photo production, as well as editing and sound recording. Volunteer's main task will be assisting to the pedagogue during the educational programs for schools, as well as during the film and animation workshops (clubs). This is who we are!

Rozmarýnek is the second oldest training facility of Lipka. It designs and implements natural science and environmental education programmes for primary and secondary schools, afternoon courses, clubs and camps, especially for kids. A lot of activities are connected with animals and are mostly run outside in the garden and the closest surroundings. Rozmarýnek has a unique natural garden with permaculture elements. It bears Model natural garden certificate confirming that we care for our garden without using e.g. peat dust, fast dissolving artificial fertilizers and pesticides. The visitors can also see special garden structures and unusual elements managing water or promoting distribution of animals on cultivated land etc. The unique garden enables Rozmarýnek to run courses on permaculture for professional public, pedagogues and enthusiasts from afar. We operate an Ecohouse as an example of environmental friendly way of living.

About the activity

The volunteer will have responsibilities mostly in these areas

- Maintenance of the natural garden, of the Ecohouse and care for animals. Garden jobs are seasonal (picking fruits, processing them, planting herbs, watering, composting, cutting grass, other manual tasks...). Animals require feeding, cleaning, repairing either terrariums or coops (we have rabbits, geese, chicken, lizards, snake, stick insects, turtles).

Within the care of the Ecohouse volunteer is among other things for example in charge of seasonal decoration or maintenance of the fireplace during Christmas programs for kids.

- Participating in afterschool hobby clubs (approx. once a week). According to his/her skills volunteer will take part in one of our hobby clubs for primary school kids (handicraft, cooking, pet breeding, scientific clubs). He/she can also lead his/her own activity within the club. Kids do not speak English but English-Czech speaking pedagogue will help. Some activities of our hobby clubs can be carried out on weekends (half-day activities).
- Participating in environmental programs for teenagers. Environmental education is the aim of our facility, so the volunteer will participate in preparing or leading activities for teenagers during one-week residential stays, weekend events and summer camps. (approximately 5 weeks during the year). Teenagers speak English.
- Public events held by the facility. (app. 5 times a year). The volunteer will also participate in preparing public events (taking photoshoot, helping with manual preparations).
- Manual preparation of aids and props for environmental programs (e.g. printing, cutting, laminating materials, handicraft). Few hours a week.
- According to his/her skills volunteer can be involved in cooking (especially vegetarian, from organic ingredients) for our culinary workshops, residential programs or camps (approximately twice a month or 4 weeks during the year).
- According to his/her language skills volunteer will lead English lessons, workshops or conversations. Few hours a week.
- Cooperating in creating posts and taking pictures for Lipka Facebook and Instagram, working with Canva editor.

30 hours weekly:

- 9 hours weekly – manual work in the garden/Ecohouse, looking after animals, preparing schooling aids and props for environmental programmes (varies through the seasons)
- 5 hours weekly – preparing and conducting programs for children (irregularly, one week stays or weekends, afternoon hobby clubs)
- 3 hours weekly – leading English lessons, workshops or conversations (with employees of Lipka or teenagers)
- 3 hours weekly – other activities (irregularly, preparation and organisation of public events, photographing, preparing materials, cooking etc.)

This is who we are!

Siska Forest Kindergarten is a non-profit non-governmental association, established in 2012. Our main aims are supporting active and responsible parenthood and education of children, supporting families and working parents, running forest kindergarten, building space for common activities and public events, informing about forest kindergartens and environmental education. The main feature of the concept of forest kindergartens is that the children are the whole day outdoors, in the forest or in the garden, no matter what the weather is.

Our main activities are

- forest kindergarten – opened daily 8 a.m. – 4 p.m. from Monday till Friday during the school year (1st September – 30th June), there are 16 children aged 3 – 7;
- one public event (festival with games) for children and their parents monthly – one afternoon during the weekend
- 3-4 camps for kids during summer holidays (daily 8 a.m. – 5 p.m. from Monday till Friday), cca 20 children aged 4-10;

About the activity

Volunteer in Siska will be working mainly as a pedagogue assistant (helping during common activities, accompanying children in the forest, assisting in regular courses for kids - music, arts, sports, handcraft etc. - according to his/her interest, during occasional events or summer camps). Volunteer will be also helping children while putting on clothes, dining etc. and may be asked to help with practical tasks connected with running the kindergarten – cooking, washing the dishes, cleaning and gardening. Volunteer will be supported to bring new ideas and organize own activities for children. English communication skills are needed.

Activities in Siska:

The morning programme in kindergarten consists of morning circle, common activity, snack, walk and games in forest. After lunch, children have a rest in a ger, listen to a story or chat. Afternoons there are different activities - music, painting, handcraft etc. or free play.

Volunteer can also offer the activities to the children according to his/her abilities and interests. This schedule changes during holiday seasons, when we organize camps for children (and discuss with volunteer his/her participation specifically).

30 hours weekly:

5. What area are you good at and you would like to share your knowledge and experience with others?

Seminars

As a volunteer within the ESC programme, 2 seminars are offered by the Czechia National Agency, in which the volunteer will meet other volunteers involved in other organizations activities and from all over Czechia.

Travel

Travel costs of the volunteer from to Czechia and back will be reimbursed to a maximum in accordance with the European Commission distance calculator and European Solidarity Corps Program Guide.

Accommodation, food and transport arrangements

Accommodation will be provided by the host organization.

Pocket money

The hosting organization will give the monthly allowance to the volunteer.

Food and Transport

The hosting organization will give the monthly allowance to the volunteer.

Visa and resident permit

For non-EU volunteers who might need a visa and stay permit, there is a budget to cover all the administrative costs. The volunteer has to keep all the invoices and proof of the expenses to be reimbursed in Czechia.

Language course

The volunteer will have access to the Online Linguistic Support offered by the EU Academy of ESC programme, that will help him/her in learning the Czech language.

Insurance

Health insurance will be provided by the ESC program.
