This is who we are!

Gatschhüpfen is a non-profit, parent-led forest kindergarten where children between the ages of 2.5 and 6 explore the world through play, imagination, and connection with nature. We believe in humanistic values, embracing diversity, inclusivity, and openness to all families – including different cultures, religions, and rainbow families.

At the heart of our philosophy is respect for each child as an individual. We accompany children on their journey, supporting them when needed, without lecturing or imposing. Our aim is to nurture self-awareness, self-confidence, and a strong sense of community.

About the activity

As a volunteer, you'll support our teachers in daily activities and have the freedom to bring your own ideas, energy, and interests to the group. You don't need to be a childcare expert – just someone who enjoys the company of children, values nature, and is open to learning.

Some of your possible tasks:

- Join the children in play, songs, crafts, and storytelling.
- Help children with dressing, packing their backpacks and other stuff.
- Accompany walks and nature explorations.
- Help children with basic hygiene (e.g. washing hands, helping with getting to the toilet).

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- Help prepare and serve lunch (once per week the teachers with the help of a volunteer prepare lunch) and afternoon snacks.
 - Participate in the trip to a nearby swimming pool in summer.
 - Share your own ideas and lead small projects or activities (upon discussion with the teachers).
 - Assist with simple gardening and caring for the yurt.
 - Participate in regular meetings with a mentor and/or teacher(s) and reflect on your learning.

- Love the outdoors and don't mind getting wet, cold, or muddy.

This is who we are!

The StudentInnenkinderhort is organized by the “Verein StudentInnenkinder” (Association for Students’ children) and located in the AKH Campus (University Campus in the 9th district in Vienna). It is divided into a kindergarten and a day nursery (Hort) for children between the age of six to ten.

We believe that only in a respectful environment, a child can develop his/her full self and his/her creativity. In our long history, we build on and continue the tradition of an education without fear of authorities to ensure that the education of humanity continue to succeed.

As a volunteer, you will work at the Hort. The opening hours of the Hort are Monday to Friday from 12 to 6 p.m., this will be your working hours as a volunteer.

About the activity

During the opening hours a volunteer should be present and interact with the children. You bring your own knowledge and experience from your cultural background. This can be music, dance, tales, cooking receipts, games, sports etc. According to your personal preferences you make the children familiar with your background. Generally, a volunteer’s work consists of the following:

- Work with the children in their leisure time
- if necessary: help with the homework

- Attend the regular program meetings of the staff and the children, where the programme of activities is discussed and defined

- Be part of the team: team meetings, once per week and meetings with parents once per month

An afternoon starts with a common meal, cooked by our own cook, followed by 1-2 hours where the children do their homework. After that, the leisure time activities start: mostly outdoors, also indoors if the weather is not nice. During the opening hours, two members of the full-time staff are always present. This means that you will never be let alone with the children.

Leisure time activities can be:

- Sports, such as swimming, football, gymnastics, ice skating. (depending on the time of the year); if you are specialized in a certain sport, it would be great, if you could teach the children; sports activities are always on Tuesday

- Creative workshops like painting, drawing, baking cookies or practising for a theatre play

- Children can also play for themselves

You can participate in the existing program but also suggest and lead activities, workshops, etc. yourself (with support of the staff) on a topic with which you are familiar and interested in.

Two weeks per year (winter and summer) there is a holiday excursion outside Vienna. During this time, you will support the staff to create a good time for and with the children. The activities depend on the season and weather: hiking/skiing, swimming, barbeque etc. You can help prepare these weeks, e.g. inventing games and activities, help with practical organisational matters or cooking together with the kids and staff. The excursion will also be an opportunity to see other parts of Austria.

This is who we are!

Caritas Vienna counsels, accompanies and supports members of our society who are currently finding themselves in a challenging situation, who are suffering from illness or the consequences of an unfortunate incident or a catastrophe. Caritas Vienna assists regardless of the social, national or religious background of the people in need. Caritas Vienna runs various departments focusing on different social challenges. One department is the so-called Department For Community Work focusing on prevention and ongoing support for people at social risk. The various projects of this department accompany housing units, foster neighbourhood helping networks, support volunteering and tackle social exclusion through community arts. One of the projects run by the department for community work is a culture centre called Kulturhaus Brotfabrik.

Kulturhaus Brotfabrik also operates a second, smaller venue at the main market square of Favoriten, the STAND 129. STAND 129 is right in the middle of the busy centre of the district and offers great opportunities for low-threshold and participatory events.

The work of Kulturhaus Brotfabrik focuses on the people living and working around its two venues but other groups are addressed as well. These groups are the main target groups of Kulturhaus Brotfabrik:

- Population / people living in the area
- People with a migration background and/or experiences of discrimination
- People who are systematically disadvantaged in the education system

The culture centre Kulturhaus Brotfabrik is a hub that transforms individual projects into a space of participatory processes (through art and social design) and engaging the community.

About the activity

The volunteers will be involved in organising different opportunities for the residents living around Kulturhaus Brotfabrik and STAND 129 to interact with each other. Besides supporting existing initiatives (art workshops, repaircafé, concerts, children's events) the volunteers are also encouraged to present their own ideas which they might come up with when getting in touch with the residents.

Kulturhaus Brotfabrik is also involved in international, EU-funded projects (Erasmus+, Creative Europe). During the volunteering period, volunteers will have the opportunity to get involved with different aspects of this project, e.g. workshops, performances, and organisational matters. The working language within the European projects is English.

This is who we are!

We provide after-school care for 14 children between six and eight years of age. Kiriku is located between the 6th and 7th district of Vienna. We are open from Monday to Friday from 12:00 to 17:30. Kiriku is run by a board which consists of the parents of the kids. In the 'Kindergruppe' itself there are two full-time caretakers, who have a pedagogical background and attended some external training, like Montessori-courses etc. Both are very warm-hearted, patient, and competent people, who are doing the best to provide a nice and warm atmosphere and support the international volunteers in the best way they can.

Our main goals are to let our children live their fantasy and their own ideas and to provide them safe surroundings so that they can express their own opinions and learn to become socially responsible. We also want to stimulate curiosity and open minds for people with different cultural backgrounds and provide the opportunity to learn other languages, what we see as key to understand people from other parts of this world. The best way to achieve these goals is to integrate young people from different countries and cultures into our project.

About the activity

Giving the children a first-hand experience with foreign languages, poems, art and music would be a benefit to all of us. Offering art and creativity occupation to the children and working with the children – together with our professional caregivers – would be our most desired approach within this project.

So during the leisure time programme for the children, we want you, as a volunteer, to start and initiate own activities for the children. You will be given the possibility to execute your own projects with the children. Whether you want to engage in arts, sports, music, history, science, language or a political subject is up to you and your interests or background. Any support necessary for your ideas will be provided by us.

Project examples could be a theme week about the country you are from (every afternoon could have a different focus, like: Music, traditions/habits, games, cooking, language etc). Another possibility would be a project about some special talent of yours.

You will also work with the children in their daily activities, like eating, doing homework, playing, and cleaning up.

You will get the opportunity to:

The Kindergruppe Simsalabim Zwerge is a small kindergarten in the 3rd district of Vienna. It's based in an apartment with a small courtyard with a sandpit and the possibility to plant some vegetables and flowers. The Kindergruppe has a kitchen, a crafting room, a gym with a slide and a room where the kids can do quieter activities like reading books or doing role

plays. Our Kindergarten is a non-profit organisation run by the parents. We have a team of 3 teachers. There are maximum 14 kids between 2 and 6 years with 2 teachers taking care of them Monday to Friday from 8 am till 4pm.

The idea of our organization is based on a humanistic philosophy. We live diversity, are open minded to different cultures, religions, and rainbow families. The main target of the teachers is to build up individual relationships with the kids and to respect and take their individual needs seriously. Our meaning of education is to accompany the children and help if they need it but not lecture them. Each child is accepted as an individual, encouraged to develop self-consciousness and self-confidence.

About the activity

Your tasks will be the following:

- play, paint, sing, read, do handcraft etc. with the children
- bring in your own ideas, plan and realize your own activities supported by the teachers or parents
- bring in your own cultural background and mother language, food etc.
- accompany the kids by public transport to outdoor trips
- help to prepare breakfast, lunch and snacks.

Your social and pedagogical learning outcomes will be the following:

You will learn how to:

- observe the children's play and not to direct it
- see the kids as individuals and learn more about their different personalities
- support to solve conflict situations or problems
- motivate kids to do things by themselves
- communicate in a non-violent way.

Our educators come from Guatemala, Spain, Austria and Germany, so our main languages are German and Spanish. We, the parents, meet regularly and share our functions in the kindergarten (e.g. cooking). Our aim is to create a protective environment for the children to convey joy of life, courage and self-assurance to them. Our pedagogy is anti-authoritarian, which means that children stand in a democratic contact with the educators – they participate in the decisions about what and how to play. Because of our two Spanish speaking educators, children also learn Spanish.

Our group is an initiative by parents who want to secure high-quality care for their children and located in the 7th district of Vienna (Wimbergergasse 13). It is a kindergarten located in the 7th district of Vienna (Kindergruppe means children's group in German). The Amerlinghaus is a cultural centre built in the early 19th century and named after the painter Friedrich Amerling. Since the 1970s the Amerlinghaus has hosted a number of NGO's in the cultural and social field.

The Kindergruppe is organized and run by parents. It hosts up to 13 children between the age of three to six. Pedagogical work follows the principles of Maria Montessori and Rebecca Wild. Through our activities, children shall be supported in their social, motoric, cognitive, creative and emotional intelligence and find the space to grow themselves.

About the activity

As an ESC volunteer, you are expected to spend around 30-38 hours per week in the kindergarten and support the staff with daily activities. You are granted the opportunity to improve your language

skills and to get important insights into the work with children. All our kindergarten teachers are well trained and support the group with their various backgrounds.

You will support our kindergarten teachers with their work, especially when the group is having lunch or they go out to the forest, playgrounds, museums and so on. We would like to encourage you to share your cultural background with us. The commitment depends on the knowledge, motivation and initiative of the volunteers. For example, one of our last volunteers had good practice in working with children and was a good musician. She therefore could offer polish songs to the group, which the children enjoyed.

This is who we are!

The kindergarten cooperates with the University of Natural Resources and Applied Life Sciences, it is organized as a parent-managed corporation. It is open to the children of students and university employees. It is located in the 18th district in Vienna, near the University, in a quiet and green neighbourhood of Vienna, surrounded by several parks. The kindergarten has one toddler group (1-3 year old children) and two family groups (2-6 year old children), in each group there are two teachers and one assistant. An employed cook prepares fresh and mainly organic food for the children and staff every day (breakfast, lunch, afternoon snack). Additionally, our members – the

children's parents – are actively involved in the kindergarten, they care about all administrative duties and join special days or excursions as extra support for the staff.

The kindergarten is financed by subsidies from the city of Vienna, a membership fee, the BOKU University, the ÖH (student Union) and special charity events to increase the budget.

In total, 55 children between one and six years visit the kindergarten.

The pedagogy of the kindergarten is based on the situational approach. The kindergarten teachers offer activities according to the needs of the children, such as creativity and sports (indoors and outdoors) and pay attention to an appreciative functioning of the community as well as to individual needs.

About the activity

As a volunteer, we would like you to give input to all these activities:

- For example, play a typical game from your home country
- Teach us songs or rhymes in your language
- Prepare a special project week about your home country
- Prepare typical food from your home country

Feel free to think of anything that could fit in with regard to your personal talents and interests

Such activities will be planned with the teachers, but you will also participate during the regular activities. Additionally, just like the other staff, the teachers and parents, you will help to clean the rooms and do some laundry (not too much!).

This is who we are!

Die Tafel Österreich is the biggest and oldest foodbank in Austria. It is an independent social and environmental organisation. It provides food to people affected by poverty and living in social institutions (refugee center, homeless shelters, mother-children-homes etc.) since 1999. The food is provided free of charge and consists of food that would otherwise have become a waste. In 2024 it saved 1 578 tons of food from being thrown away and supported 75 000 people in 160 social institutions all over Austria with it. The organisation and its work are made possible by donations – time (290 volunteers 2024), money and food.

This is who we are!

The Kindergarten “Kinderladen Hütteldorf” was founded by parents and kindergarten teachers for the collective supervision of children aged 2 to 6 with shared goals and contents. This type of kindergarten is called “Kindergruppe”. Our Kindergruppe is located in the west of Vienna, in the district “Penzing”, which has many green areas, including the Vienna Woods. The Kindergruppe is managed by the parents, and there are two caregivers for 13 children between the ages of 2 to 6. In everyday work, the most valuable is respect, room for individual development, and a feeling of security. The team and parents let themselves be guided by the needs of the children and decide together with them the daily activities.

About the activity

As a volunteer, you would be present about 30 hours per week (maximum 38 hours per week). The opening hours of the Kindergruppe are Monday to Friday, 08:00 – 16:00. You will have your lunch with the children. Furthermore, there are regular planning meetings with the parents and the teachers.

You will be integrated into the daily schedule of the Kindergruppe and will support our team of pedagogues. This includes welcoming the children, helping them with their clothing, participating in the morning activities, such as playing music, handcrafting, drawing, cooking and baking, going outside into nature, as well as observing and supporting the children in their doing and needs. Many activities are organized according to the different themes and seasons throughout the year: e.g., Christmas, Easter, Spring, Autumn, etc. Additionally, there are small events, for example, the Summer Party. This is a common activity for all parents, staff, and children. As a volunteer, you are welcome not only to support and give input to all the regular activities, but also to create projects of your own. For example, you could offer activities and projects about your home country (making typical food, learning dances and songs from your culture, etc.), or anything related to your interests and talents. As a volunteer, you are invited to join the colorful group of children, parents, and pedagogues at learning, growing, and experiencing together.
