Britanica is a non-profit organization founded in 2004 with the goal of integrating Estonian children into European society. Its primary objective is to provide a learning environment where local children can acquire proficiency in at least two European languages, English and German, through both formal and informal methods. Britanica aims to foster international understanding, solidarity, and dialogue among young people and children worldwide.

Since 2005, Britanica has hosted international volunteers, enriching the organization's ability to offer young people an opportunity to explore Europe and other continents—not only through language but also through exposure to diverse cultures, customs, food, music, and more. This project enhances intercultural learning for children, staff, and parents alike.

The organization serves 50-80 children, ages 8 to 17, most of whom are native Russian speakers. As such, the project focuses on integrating an ethnic minority group within Estonia. Intercultural learning and foreign language experiences are incorporated into daily activities such as workshops (e.g., drawing, seasonal crafts), attending local cultural events, visits and excursions, teamwork exercises, formal language lessons, and clubs like Reading and Conversation. This is who we are!

The main goal of the Kristiine Kindergarten is to support families in preparing children for school and to teach and develop children's physical, mental and social skills. The values of the organisation are openness, creativity, tolerance, respect, caring and courage. The kindergarten has 12 classes for 1.5-7 years old children. The main activity is to teach children creatively through play. The kindergarten is in a green district of the Estonian capital within walking distance or short public transport trip from downtown.

By including an international volunteer in our kindergarten, our goal is to improve together our main values through intercultural learning and get a fresh bystander view of our organisation. At the same time, the volunteer can contribute with innovative ideas to engage with children, parents, teachers and the community.

About the activity

The volunteer takes part and observes the activities each morning and has the opportunity to observe other classes too. In the early days the volunteer has fewer tasks in the teaching process and later has the opportunity to plan whole morning activity if he/she is willing. Afternoons are mostly free, but it can change due to events and weeks plans. The volunteer can participate in kindergarten events, which are planned in the beginning of the school year and are marked in the event plan, which is given in the beginning of the service. In addition, various trainings/classes are organized by kindergarten for teachers and by teachers, which the volunteer can participate in.

Also once a month, a teachers' information session takes place, where an overview of upcoming events and important information is provided, the upcoming tasks are discussed and the process of carrying out various projects is observed. Theme events with parents take place throughout the year, in which the volunteer can contribute or organize them if he/she wishes. Few weekends can include events with parents or with teachers. The volunteer has the opportunity to help to improve implementation of projects like "Free of bullying", "Eco schools" and "Health promotion". We will organize meetings with other volunteers nearby if possible. A volunteer can organize community events, such as an afternoon event for children and parents with another volunteers nearby (from other kindergartens, schools or youth center).

The main tasks of the volunteer will be:

- Contribute to daily kindergarten activities
- Enrich the children's and staff worldview with your culture and language
- Add your vision in organizing events for children
- Participate in class field trips to explore Estonian culture and nature

The main goal of Tihase kindergarten is to provide high-quality preschool education. It is important for the organisation to make the children feel welcome, safe and positive throughout the day and happy to take part in learning activities. The priority for the kindergarten is an outdoor education.

In addition to the daily learning activities taking place in the kindergarten, the children can participate in different activities like dancing, sports, music, playing zither and English lessons. The kindergarten follows many traditions like Christmas fairs, kindergarten's birthday and Estonian Independence Day. In addition to celebrating traditional activities in kindergarten, national and international health days are very important, e.g. Heart Week, Bread and Milk Week etc.

The kindergarten has 4 groups of children between the ages of 2 and 7. The maximum number of children per group is 24 and each group has 2 teachers and an assistant.

The staff is made up of 18 people. All the teachers have a pedagogical education. The kindergarten also has a music teacher and a physical education teacher.

The teachers have annual conversations with the parents to provide feedback on the child's development. The teachers are open-minded and want to extend their knowledge by getting to know people of different cultures and nations. Also, the culture and customs of our own nation are of great importance to our organisation.

The kindergarten cooperates with other organisations, such as nearby kindergartens, different theatre groups and their district government. Since June 2016 Tihase Kindergarten belongs to a network of kindergartens aiming to educate children on health.

About the activity

- Help teachers with lessons and games for children
- Prepare lessons and materials for activities
- Help to prepare festivals, holidays and exhibitions
- Prepare a presentation about own country
- Organise different events for teachers, such as culture clubs
- Take part in different activities, such as parties, excursions, study trips etc
- Assist kids (getting dressed for the outdoor activities, having meals)
- Gather up toys or books after play time

Tallinna Laagna Lasteaed-Põhikool combines kindergarten and elementary school. Their aim is to provide education for disabled children and teach them social skills so that they will be able to manage on their own in their future lives. They give opportunity for children's development providing secure, joyful, comfortable atmosphere and using individual approach to every child.

Their target group consists of 36 school children with special needs, aged from 7 to 17 years old and regular activities include lessons in accordance with compulsory educational programmes, followed by different activities provided by teachers, therapists and others. Children usually stay at school until 6 p.m. After obligatory classes they have rest, lunch break and optional leisure activities, including indoor and outdoor games; after that they usually do their homework with the help of teachers on duty and then go home.

About the activity

- Supporting the personnel in looking after the children and running daily tasks – helping staff during the lessons and free time
- Playing with children
- Helping staff to organize leisure time activities

Mainly the assistance of the volunteer is needed during the breaks and after lessons to organize different indoor and outdoor games with children. These could involve different table games, ball games, etc. During the lessons sometimes our children need individual assistance in performing such simple tasks as opening books, taking a pen into their hand, switching on a computer etc.

Kindergarten Kullerkupu was established in 1963. At present, there are four groups – each group of 20-24 children, altogether around 90 children aged 1,5 to 7 years old.

One of the priorities is innovation, to be modern. Kindergarten has joined the projects ” Free of Bullying“ and Eco school. The importance of environmental protection is attached to everyday life. In addition to the daily learning activities taking place in kindergarten, there are also music and sports. Kindergarten has a nice outdoor area and several events are held outdoors.

The main purpose of the organization is a high-quality basic education for children. The mission is to welcome every child in their friendly family and to provide pleasant conditions for a child to contribute to the development of their personality. This is who we are!

Tallinn Center for Children at Risk is a welfare organization, where children who have been left without parental care or have behavioral or substance abuse problems, get professional help. This organisation has two centers in Tallinn: Lilleküla Shelter and Männi Shelter.

Children are hosted in these two shelters for various reasons, most common are vagrancy, home negligence, family violence, parental alcoholism or drug abuse, parental unemployment or loss of residence due to family poverty. Most of the children are brought to the shelter by the police or child protection worker.

The staff that works directly with the children consists of the manager of shelter, nine social workers and a nurse who all aim to provide the children a safe environment which helps to foster their personal development. Approximately 75% of shelter children are sent back home after their stay in the Shelter. If necessary, they remain under the supervision of the welfare worker.

About the activity

After on-arrival orientation meeting aimed at the integration of the volunteer to local realities and explanation of aims and activities of the host project, the ESC volunteer will be carrying out the following tasks:

- Looking after the children and youth and helping staff in teaching them different useful skills
- Running additional educational activities in the house using its own facilities
- Teaching children foreign languages through joined games, songs, sport, any other activities indoor and outdoor, which the ESC volunteer will be running
- Presenting his/ her home country and its culture as a part of intercultural learning
- Arranging children's outings, e.g. culture visits, excursions, hikes, picnics, etc.
- Playing with children

Participation of motivated ESC volunteer is seen as an exciting innovative element refreshing the daily routine and bringing additional educational value to the pedagogical process. The main idea is to provide assistance and support local personnel in daily work, particularly in running various educational and free time activities for the children and youth. It is also to provide some experience and practice of foreign languages and intercultural learning both for children and local personnel. At the same time it gives valuable field experience of the social and youth work to the ESC volunteer accepted to the project.

A lot depends on volunteer's personality and mutual agreements. We expect the volunteer to be working from Tuesday to Saturday and sometimes on mutual agreement to work on Sundays because the children are more available then for different activities. In that case volunteer's two free days will be during the week. Together with the volunteers the goals and objectives of the ESC will be set. Weekly plans will help set the frames and organise time. Since Tallinna Laste Turvakeskus has a long experience with volunteers, we know how to support and empower them. Our psychologists can also help with extra counselling if needed.

Tallinn Shelter, established on January 1, 2001, aims to provide a safe and secure environment for children and young people without parental care, while also supporting families with children who might have special needs. The shelter offers a range of social services, with the most significant being the substitute home service.

The shelter is organized into 13 units, including the Shelter for Children and the Shelter for Mothers and Children. Both units have been welcoming EVS and ESC volunteers since 2005.

The primary goal of the Shelter for Mothers and Children is to protect mothers and their children, while also empowering mothers to regain their self-confidence and independence. Many seek assistance due to issues such as housing instability, family conflicts, and domestic violence. The shelter supports mothers by helping them manage their lives, find employment, register at food banks, and more. Additionally, providing a listening ear and offering advice are crucial components of the assistance provided.

About the activity

The volunteers' main tasks are spending time with kids in the shelter, helping with organizing birthdays, holidays, special events, making crafts and decorations with the kids and mothers, helping shelter with different everyday tasks. The volunteer has the opportunity to visit various cultural institutions with families. The exact tasks will be agreed on together with the tutor. Some examples of the proposed tasks are:

- Running different workshops for the mothers and children in the Shelter (e.g. drawing, handcrafting, singing, sewing)
- Helping to organize and search different possibilities to expose the works or the achievements made by the mothers and their children in the Shelter (e.g. exhibitions)
- Introducing one's culture and running cultural evenings as a part of intercultural learning
- Organizing events in the Shelter: (e.g. movie evenings, reading books, teaching one's mother tongue, cooking with the mothers and their children etc.)
- Helping to organize Estonian National holidays and the birthdays of the mothers and their children
- Organizing outdoor activities (using recourses of beautiful Nõmme nature – a perfect place for skiing in winter, picnics or cycling in summer)

The volunteer will be encouraged to propose one's personal projects/initiatives related to the theme of this ESC project which can be supported by the host organization.

The volunteer can take part in local as well as in international training activities related to one's service.

The working hours will be around 7 hours a day from 10:00 or 11:00 (depends on the agreement between the volunteer and the tutor). The total working time will be around 30-35 hours a week. The volunteer will have 2 sequence days off per week. Volunteers will be working under the supervision and with support of local pedagogical staff.

Volunteer Profile

- Age: 18–30 years old
- The motivation for working with children.
- Experience in working with children or adults.
- Be open-minded and interested in work at social organisation.
- The volunteer can speak Russian at an intermediate level because the social workers at the center know only Estonian and Russian and at the same time, most mothers and children are Russian.

Seminars

As a volunteer within the ESC programme, 2 seminars are offered by the Estonia National Agency, in which the volunteer will meet other volunteers involved in other organizations activities and from all over Estonia.

Travel

Travel costs of the volunteer from to Estonia and back will be reimbursed to a maximum in accordance with the European Commission distance calculator and European Solidarity Corps Program Guide.

Accommodation, food and transport arrangements

Accommodation will be provided by the host organization.

Pocket money

The hosting organization will give the monthly allowance to the volunteer.

Food and Transport

The hosting organization will give the monthly allowance to the volunteer.

Visa and resident permit

For non-EU volunteers who might need a visa and stay permit, there is a budget to cover all the administrative costs. The volunteer has to keep all the invoices and proof of the expenses to be reimbursed in Estonia.

Language course

The volunteer will have access to the Online Linguistic Support offered by the EU Academy of ESC programme, that will help him/her in learning the Estonian language.

Insurance

Health insurance will be provided by the ESC program.
