This is who we are!

The organization is a public–private partnership established in 2011 under the LEADER initiative of the European Union ' s Rural Development Policy. Its main mission is to foster sustainable and integrated local development, improving the quality of life and strengthening the local economy across the Banat-Vest region. The organization brings together municipalities, local entrepreneurs, and non-governmental organizations to design and implement strategies that respond to local needs. Now in its third Local Development Strategy, the organization focuses on: Encouraging innovation and entrepreneurship, Supporting youth and community initiatives, Preserving cultural heritage and environmental balance, Promoting social inclusion and solidarity. In recent years, the host organization has successfully implemented several Erasmus+ and European Solidarity Corps projects, expanding its experience and capacity to host international volunteers.

About the activity

MAIN ACTIVITIES ACTIVITY

ACTIVITY 1: THE TIMEKEEPER - DIGITALIZATION AT THE PRESS MUSEUM “SEVER BOCU”

You will help scan, organize, and archive historic newspapers and magazines. You will contribute to digital preservation and assist in exhibitions that promote Romania ' s press and media heritage. Skills gained: teamwork, research, digital archiving, attention to detail, historical insight. Your main tasks will include scanning and organizing printed archives, creating digital records, and helping to make this valuable information accessible to everyone. It' s a mix of technical work and storytelling — because every newspaper page hides a fragment of real life, a piece of someone ' s story, or a glimpse of the world as it once was. Volunteers also join temporary exhibitions, cultural events, or creative camps organized in Jimbolia.

These activities allow you to work alongside curators, historians, and artists — transforming the knowledge you ' ve gained into interactive and inspiring experiences for the public. *Fun fact: While exploring the archives, you might stumble upon the newspaper published on the very day you were born — or even discover what made the headlines a hundred years before that. Every page hides a story waiting to be found!

ACTIVITY 2: THE CREATOR - GRAPHIC DESIGN & COMMUNICATION

As part of the graphic design team, you 'll help create visual materials that represent Jimbolia, the local community, and the activities carried out by volunteers and partner organizations such as the Local Action Group (GAL). What you 'll gain: Hands-on experience in design and visual communication. Skills in creativity, teamwork, and project planning. A chance to see your work displayed in real events and online campaigns. Insight into how art and media can strengthen community identity. Freedom to express yourself while supporting meaningful local projects. Your tasks may include: designing posters, flyers, and banners for events; creating social media posts or short videos to promote local initiatives; brainstorming visual concepts for cultural or community projects; developing informative materials about the town, its museums, traditions, and people. You 'll have the freedom to experiment with your own artistic style, while learning how to adapt your work to real projects and audiences. You might collaborate with museum staff, local NGOs, schools, or other volunteers — turning ideas into visuals that capture attention and tell authentic stories about Jimbolia. * Good to know: For this activity, it ' s highly recommended that volunteers bring their own creative tools — such as a personal laptop and the design software they are most comfortable with. This makes it easier to work efficiently and to fully express your creativity. Of course, guidance and support will always be available if you need help or feedback.

ACTIVITY 3: THE HEART-MAKER - EDUCATIONAL & CREATIVE WORKSHOPS FOR CHILDREN

If you love working with children and enjoy sharing your creativity, the Blytshwood Banat Day Center is the perfect place for you! Here, volunteers have the chance to design and lead fun and educational workshops for local children. Skills gained: leadership, teaching, empathy, creativity, intercultural awareness. What you 'll gain: Experience in non-formal education and child interaction. Skills in creativity, planning, and teamwork. Confidence in leading workshops and sharing your talents. A deeper connection with the local community through joyful learning moments. The satisfaction of inspiring and bringing happiness to children. You will organize fun and educational workshops at the Blythwood Banat Day Center and local schools.

Activities may include: Music workshops – use the instruments available in the center ' s music room to explore rhythm, melody, and teamwork through sound.

You can even teach children how to perform simple songs or create musical games together. Theatre and puppet shows – help kids prepare short performances, design their own act, and they already have a stage setting. The center has a dedicated room where all materials are provided, so imagination is the only limit! Creative arts & crafts – painting, DIY decorations, or crafting sessions where children can express themselves freely and proudly present their work.

ACTIVITY 4: THE PHOTOGRAPHER - “THROUGH THE LENS OF BANAT” – RURAL LIFE PHOTOGRAPHY & EXHIBITION

Volunteers will explore the Banat-Vest region and capture everyday moments that reflect the authentic charm of rural life — traditions, crafts, people, and landscapes that define the community spirit of the area. Throughout the project, they will travel to villages within the LAG Banat territory, interact with locals, and take photographs that tell real stories about life in the countryside. At the end of this creative journey, volunteers will curate and organize a public exhibition with the theme: “Life in the Villages of Banat – Seen Through the Lens of the Volunteers. ” The exhibition will take place in Jimbolia or one of the partner communes and will be open to the local community, offering a space for dialogue, appreciation, and cultural exchange. Skills gained: photography, visual storytelling, intercultural communication, exhibition planning, teamwork, and creativity.

ACTIVITY 5: THE PLANNER - “COMMUNITY VIBES” – LOCAL EVENTS & CULTURAL ENGAGEMENT

Volunteers will help organize community-centered events designed to bring people together, celebrate diversity, and create joyful shared experiences. These activities aim to strengthen the bond between international volunteers and local residents, while encouraging participation and creativity. Examples of events include: Music Bingo Nights – combining fun and friendly competition through songs and laughter. Pickle Tasting Festival – celebrating traditional homemade recipes and rural flavors. Ugly Christmas Sweater Party – spreading holiday cheer and community warmth. Other spontaneous social gatherings, creative workshops, or outdoor activities may also take place throughout the year, depending on the season and community interest. Skills gained: event planning, teamwork, public communication, organization, and intercultural collaboration.

Volunteer Profile

We are looking for motivated, open-minded young people who want to make a difference. Requirements: Aged between 18 and 30 years, Resident of an EU or ESC partner country, Not having completed a long-term ESC project before, Communicative, flexible, and motivated to learn, Interested in education, design, culture, or community work, Basic English knowledge (Romanian language will be learned during the project). Experience in volunteering or youth work is appreciated but not required.

Seminars

As a volunteer within the ESC programme, 2 seminars are offered by the Romania National Agency, in which the volunteer will meet other volunteers involved in other organizations activities and from all over Romania.

Travel

Travel costs of the volunteer from to Romania and back will be reimbursed to a maximum in accordance with the European Commission distance calculator and European Solidarity Corps Program Guide.

Accommodation, food and transport arrangements

Accommodation will be provided by the host organization.

Pocket money

The hosting organization will give the monthly allowance to the volunteer.

Food and Transport

The hosting organization will give the monthly allowance to the volunteer.

Visa and resident permit

For non-EU volunteers who might need a visa and stay permit, there is a budget to cover all the administrative costs. The volunteer has to keep all the invoices and proof of the expenses to be reimbursed in Romania.

Language course

The volunteer will have access to the Online Linguistic Support offered by the EU Academy of ESC programme, that will help him/her in learning the language.

Insurance

Health insurance will be provided by the ESC program.

Belgelerinizi hazırladıktan sonra aşağıdaki adımları izleyerek başvurunuzu tamamlayabilirsiniz:

1. Başvuru için ilk olarak <https://genclikcalismalari.org/> web sitesinde **üye girişi** yapınız. Eğer üyelik hesabınız yoksa bir hesap oluşturmanız gerekmektedir.
2. Daha sonra ilanın yayınlandığı sayfada yer alan **"Başvur"** butonuna tıklayınız ve açılan pencerede sizden talep edilen belgeleri ayrı ayrı ilgili alanlara yükleyiniz. Hangi belgelerin talep edildiği bilgi paketinde belirtilmiştir.
3. Belgeleri yükledikten sonra pencerenin alt kısmına yer alan **"Sonraki"** butonuna basınız. Yeni pencerede karşınıza **"Başvur"** butonu çıkacaktır.
4. **"Başvur"** butonuna son kez tıkladığınızda site seçtiğiniz belgeleri yüklemeye başlayacaktır. Yükleme süresi internet bağlantı hızınıza ve belgelerin boyutuna göre değişebilir ama genellikle 1 dakikadan az sürer.
