This is who we are!

We support volunteer initiatives, organize youth exchanges, trainings, summer and winter camps for kids, language classes, thematic workshops and local events. We enable people to go abroad through EKS and Erasmus+ programs! We act in Leszno and the Leszno region but also across Europe! We've been hosting volunteers for 17 years. We've worked with volunteers from Europe but also from the furthest corners of the world. We've implemented more than 30 volunteering projects so far! Our activities focus on supporting the development of children and young people, equalizing educational opportunities and disseminating culture.

About the Activity

Voices Across Generations is an international volunteering project focused on fostering dialogue, inclusion, and mutual understanding between young people and seniors, with particular attention to the experiences of migrants and refugees.

Volunteers will work closely with youth and senior groups, supporting activities that encourage intercultural exchange, social participation, and community engagement. Through non-formal education methods, discussions, creative workshops, and interactive activities, participants will create spaces where different generations and cultural backgrounds can share their stories, experiences, and perspectives.

Volunteers will design and facilitate workshops based on their own skills, talents, and interests, conducted primarily in English. They will also prepare cultural presentations, organize community-building activities, and promote values of diversity, solidarity, and active citizenship.

By engaging both young people and older adults in meaningful dialogue, volunteers will help strengthen social cohesion, challenge stereotypes, and increase awareness of migration and refugee-related issues. Activities will focus on building empathy, fostering intercultural understanding, and empowering participants to become active members of their communities.

Working closely with fellow international volunteers and project coordinators, participants will gain valuable experience in teamwork, intercultural communication, facilitation, and community work. They will also have the opportunity to learn more about Polish culture and improve their Polish language skills.

1. Başvuru için ilk olarak <https://genclikcalismalari.org/> web sitesinde **üye girişi** yapınız. Eğer üyelik hesabınız yoksa bir hesap oluşturmanız gerekmektedir.
2. Daha sonra ilanın yayınlandığı sayfada yer alan **"Başvur"** butonuna tıklayınız ve açılan pencerede sizden talep edilen belgeleri ayrı ayrı ilgili alanlara yükleyiniz. Hangi belgelerin talep edildiği bilgi paketinde belirtilmiştir.
3. Belgeleri yükledikten sonra pencerenin alt kısmına yer alan **"Sonraki"** butonuna basınız. Yeni pencerede karşınıza **"Başvur"** butonu çıkacaktır.
4. **"Başvur"** butonuna son kez tıkladığınızda site seçtiğiniz belgeleri yüklemeye başlayacaktır. Yükleme süresi internet bağlantı hızınıza ve belgelerin boyutuna göre değişebilir ama genellikle 1 dakikadan az sürer.
